Trying to work out when the Fed will cut US interest rates - and by how much - is somewhat preoccupying financial markets. Watch what ING's James Knightley thinks.

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After a bumpy few months, markets are looking to the US Federal Reserve to cut rates later this year, maybe by half a percentage point. But something might be changing. Sure, Donald Trump wants deeper, faster cuts. And now some members of the Fed board appear to be coming round to the idea of reducing borrowing costs as early as July.
