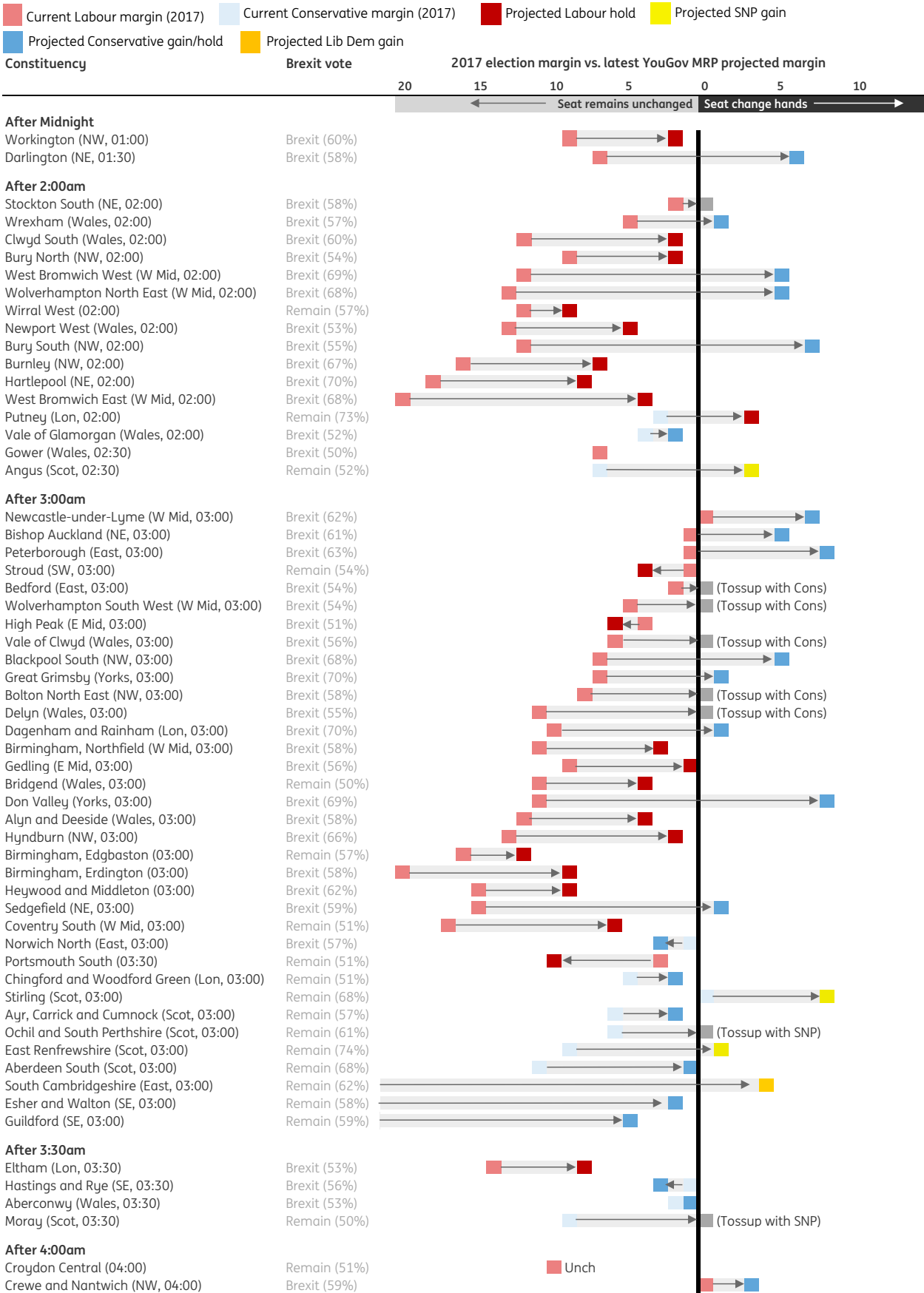
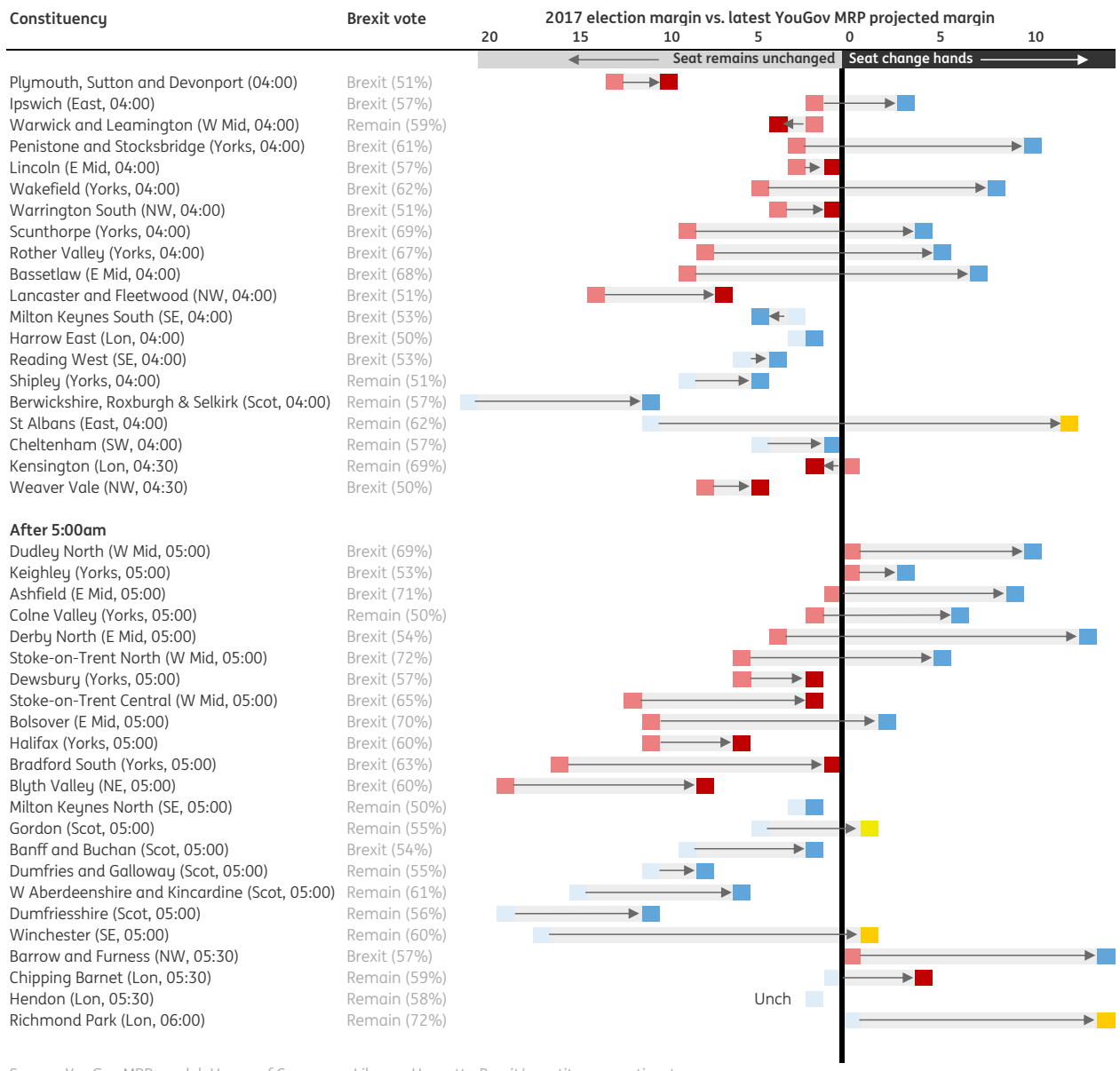


It's make-or-break for PM Boris Johnson's Conservatives. If you're planning to follow the UK election through the night, we've filtered through the 650 seats up for grabs to highlight those that will be to the Conservative's battle for a majority. The table below shows who held the seat in 2017 (and by what margin), compared to the latest prediction of the YouGov MRP election model. That includes:

- Labour seats that are vulnerable to Conservative gain (and vice versa)
- Conservative seats vulnerable to Lib Dem gain (and vice versa)
- Conservative seats vulnerable to Scottish National Party gain
